SPORT SCHOLARSHIP

1. The applicant should be of provincial standard in at least one sport, and proof of provincial colours should be submitted with the application. The applicant should play at least two other sports offered at St Teresa's School at A-team standard.
2. On receipt of an application, we will schedule an interview at which the applicant will be required to demonstrate her skills in the sports indicated on the form.
3. Applications close on **Friday, 1 March at 12h00 midday**, and interviews will be conducted from **5 March 2024**.
4. Applicants for all scholarships must write the Scholarship Examinations taking place on **Wednesday, 6 March 2024**.
5. No award will be made if the skill and ability demonstrated are insufficient to justify it. The award is subject to the candidate maintaining a high standard of academic work, sporting achievement, and conduct.
6. Provision will not be made for the interview to be conducted on an alternative day.
7. The decisions of the Bursary & Scholarship Committee in awarding this scholarship will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into in this regard.
8. Mrs de Bod, the High School Principal, will notify the winners telephonically on **15 March 2024**. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the results of the interviews. The scholarship will commence at the beginning of 2025.
9. Should your daughter's scholarship application be successful and accepted, the full admissions process will be followed.
10. A detailed Grade 6 report will be required to make an application. In addition, any talent displayed by the candidate in music, dramatic arts, and/or visual arts should be mentioned. We reserve the right to request a letter of recommendation from the head of the school that the candidate currently attends. A sports CV must be submitted with the application.
11. Unsuccessful candidates are not obligated to attend St Teresa's School.
12. Before making an application, parents should consult the Head of the school currently attended by their daughter.
