ALL OPEN ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Scholarships will be awarded based on the results of a scholarship examination and/or interview, open to girls presently in Grade 7. Details and the criteria relating to each scholarship are attached. The awards are subject to excellent reports on work and conduct.
2. Awards will not be made unless the standard of work in the examination is considered high enough to justify them.
3. The examination will consist of:
 - A paper in English incorporating comprehension, creative writing, general knowledge, general skills, and interpretation of facts and data.
 - A paper in Mathematics.
 - There is no set syllabus used for any of the above – the student's general level of ability will be tested.
4. The closing date for receipt of applications is **Friday, 1 March, at 12h00 midday**; no exceptions will be permitted.
5. Applicants must complete the enclosed application form. Unsuccessful candidates are not obligated to attend St Teresa's School.
6. Papers will be written at St Teresa's School on **Wednesday, 6 March at 14h00**.
7. Provision will **NOT** be made for the examination to be written on an alternative day.
8. The decisions of the Bursary & Scholarship Committee in awarding the scholarships will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into in this regard.
9. Mrs de Bod, the High School Principal, will notify the winners telephonically on **15 March 2024**. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the results of the scholarship examination. The scholarships will commence at the beginning of 2025.
10. Should your daughter's scholarship application be successful and accepted, the full admissions process will be followed.
11. A detailed Grade 6 report will be required to make an application. In addition, any talent displayed by the candidate in music, dramatic arts, and/or visual arts should be mentioned. We reserve the right to request a letter of recommendation from the Head of the school that the candidate currently attends.
12. Before making an application, parents should consult the Head of the school currently attended by their daughter.
